Students/pupils are encouraged not to put their hands in their mouths / to their eyes etc. after touching Winston. Winston is regularly washed / cleaned by the owner and has regular checks by a suitably qualified vet. Winston has undergone flea treatments on a regular basis. Allergy to certain animals	 Persons with known allergies to dogs are exempt from handling or getting exposed for long periods to Winston therefore Winstons refuge area should be located away from persons with allergies to pet hair. Disposable gloves or other personal protective equipment can be provided and worn by the person if required. Parents are informed that Winston is part of the school environment and must give express permission for their child to be in proximity of Winston therefore Winstons refuge area must be located away from student/pupil access areas. Allergies and Anaphylaxis risk assessment available. 	4	2	8	
3.	Animals in school	 Ensure hands are washed before and after handling. Ensure Winston's house/cage is clean and disinfected regularly. Prevent contact between Winston's food and wild animals to avoid disease transmission. Carefully wash all scratches or bites. If in any doubt about infection seek medical advice. Winston should not be in school when conducting a fire or lockdown drill. Teaching staff who are undertaking the provision of lessons to students/pupils ensure that another trained staff member is available to attend to Winston or that Winston is taken to its refuge area. 	3	2	6
