# Road Safety

This is reminder to ALL in light of the recent tragic news of the death of 11 year old Evan Rothwell who was tragically killed outside of his school.

Please ensure your child is supervised on the car park outside school. This includes children walking, cycling or leaving the car. Children have been observed running and cycling across the carpark without looking and without parental supervision.

If walking to school with your child please ensure you adequately supervise your child when crossing roads. Those children who walk to and from school alone please remind them of the importance of safely crossing the road. Children will be reminded about road safety in school.

Car users I cannot stress the importance of adhering to the speed limit when using the roads around school at all times. When entering the school car park drivers are reminded to maintain a speed of no more than 5 mph.

Please take a moment to think how you would feel if you tragically killed or injured a child who you would probably know along with their family, and the impact it would have on our school community.
